Course title	The Writing Process
Target participants	All students
Course aims	To develop students' understanding of the academic writing process.
Learning outcomes	By the end of the session, students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• make maps and plans for their academic writing• review the structure of a draft• improve written style• apply a three-step process for proofreading
Course description	<p>This course introduces students to the academic writing process.</p> <p>The first session teaches techniques to help students organise their ideas before they begin writing. Sessions 2 and 3 cover strategies for reviewing the structure of a draft and improving written style. The final session shows students how to identify errors and inconsistencies in their writing through a three-step proofreading process.</p> <p>Note: The final session of The Writing Process covers the same content as the Proofreading Your Final Draft workshop.</p> <p>Session 1 Mapping and Planning Session 2 Drafting and Revising Session 3 Editing Session 4 Proofreading</p>
