Tuesday, 27 April	Session 6: Verb Tense 'Tense' refers to the verb form that specifies a point or period of time. This session covers when and how to use different tenses in academic writing. Students will practise using texts to develop their understanding of different tenses.
Tuesday, 4 May	Session 7: Paragraph Structure 1 In this workshop students will read and analyse a paragraph; understand the function of the topic sentence and paragraph structure; and use their knowledge of paragraph structure in the production of a paragraph.
Tuesday, 11 May	Session 8: Prepositions and Collocations Learn how to find appropriate prepositions. Practise using a collocation dictionary.
Tuesday, 18 May	Session 9: Using Source Material This workshop will cover the overall logic of using sources, when and how to reference them appropriately, and tips on common reporting verbs.
Tuesday, 25 May	Session 10: Writing in Your Own Words 1: Paraphrasing Paraphrasing means putting someone else's sentences into your own words. In this session you will learn a two-stage process for paraphrasing which involves changing both the structure and the words of a sentence.
Tuesday, 1 June	Session 11: Connecting Ideas In this session you will learn how to start and join clauses to make connections between ideas in your writing.
